VIRTUAL EXAMINATIONS: CODE OF CONDUCT

- Students will take the exams from the safe and secure environment of his/her home.
- Parent should arrange for desktop/laptop (with a webcam)/mobile with functional passwords for apps related to MS teams/forms/notebook
- An internet connection (high speed un-interrupted internet is desirable).
- 'Honesty is the best Policy' and it has to be put into action during these virtual examinations. Self-monitoring, honesty and ethical values of both the student and the parents will play an important part in this online format.
- Candidate should be seated in front of the desktop / Laptop/ mobile, facing the screen and webcam throughout the entire duration of the test.
- Student should report to his exam desk ten minutes before the commencement of the exam.
- Ensure comfortable and sturdy sitting position. Do not slouch or lie during paper.
- Candidate should be in school uniform while taking the test.
- Any mobile number change, login - password issues to be sorted before 6th of July , 2021. The parent should inform on the school no. **8859999882** about it and it will be sorted before 6th of July , 2021. **Any technical problem after that and on the exam day will not be entertained and student will be marked absent.**

GENERAL THINGS TO REMEMBER ON THE EXAMINATION DAY.

- Keep your VIDEO ON during exam
- Attend the Roll Call by Invigilator.

Before the Exam:

- Link to the paper will be provided 5 mins prior on Subject Channels of MS Teams.
- If using phone to attend the paper, kindly Split Screen.
- Click the submit button to submit the answer sheet. **Don't forget to upload the Subjective part in the same question paper before submission.**
- (Submit the paper 5-10 minutes before to avoid problems (9:45 a.m. -9:55 a.m.)

FOR SUBJECTIVE PART: (For Classes I-V)

- Ensure that all the pages of your answer sheet are serially numbered.
- Mention your full name, roll number, class, section, subject and date on the answer sheet.
- Get comfortable and keep all required things with you.

During Exam:

- Follow complete instructions as asked in the Question Paper.
- Mention correct question number while answering.
- Maintain the speed from the beginning itself and complete the paper within the time allotted.
- Write neatly.
- It is strictly advised that the candidate should not leave the seat during the test. Bio breaks are not permitted.

After Exam:

- After the exam is over make PDF of the pages of answers attempted in your copy.
- Within 5 minutes upload this PDF in the of your exam paper.
